LAMINATING

Thank you to all of the new recruits on the laminating roster. Meagan Hanson, Jenny Mckenzie, Siobhan Norman and Dianne Ayre. These volunteers have put their hand up to help laminate posters and in-class resources for our teachers and for the outside community. The idea is to get about 8 people on a laminating roster so that all that will be required is about 1 hour every 8 weeks. The laminator is owned and run by the P&C so any profit goes back into OUR SCHOOL. **Laminating costs are A4 - \$1.50, A3 - \$3.00, A5 - \$1.00 and large posters sizes charged at \$8.00 per metre**, so, if you know anyone who needs laminating done, tell them to come to the library, fill in a laminating form and leave it for our rostered volunteers. Turnaround is usually every week.

I will be compiling an up-to-date roster soon and will roster on new recruits with present experienced volunteers who are willing to show you the ropes. Thank you ladies.
