Where: Sculptures will be exhibited within school grounds

Materials: You can use anything you like- recycled materials- wood off-cuts, metal, found objects.

Why: To engage the community in a fun and social way of learning more about art.

Calling all crafty/tradie mums, dads, grandparents and neighbours to get out your tools, get creative, show off your talents and skills and have fun with your children.

Do you knit or weave? Can you weld? Can you use a drill, hammer or a hot glue gun? We want you!!

Will your sculpture require a specific location? Perhaps your sculpture will dangle suspended from a tree or be nestled amongst some bushes?

Sculptures could be an installation of collected materials arranged in a special formation. They could be giant super-sized objects or be a symbolic representation of what comes to mind when you think about 'Spring.'

Will your sculpture disappear after the rain, deteriorate over time or will it be able to endure the elements and become a permanent feature of Bull Creek Primary School?

For inspiration you could google some examples of sculpture from *Sculpture by the Sea*.
